The ability to identify the type of communication styles shows you how to create a "Likeability Factor" in the job interview. The "Tips" learned in this program will teach you how to develop a rapport with the interviewer – necessary in creating the "Likeability Factor." Below is a chart that identifies how the interviewee is rated.

Out of a 100% possibility that the candidate will win a job offer –

- 50% = "Likeability Factor" The mirror effect (Isopraxism)
 - o 40% = Is Voice
 - o 10% = Is Image and Demeanor

The other 50% is as follows:

- **♣** 30% = Is if they think you want the job
- 20% = Is if they think they can work with you

Attendees who master the "Art of Interviewing" and use the skills to build a rapport with an interviewer will be the most likely candidate that rates 100% "Likeability Factor" and gets that job offer – not finished yet – next...Salary Negotiations!
